Role Summary

Applications are invited from suitably qualified candidates for the post of locum Consultant Child and Adolescent Psychiatrist with St John of God Community Mental Health Services, Lucena Part-Time (0.5 WTE) basis. This post is a backfill for clinical time for the Clinical Director. It will be initially based in Lucena clinic, Team C in Rathgar which delivers the full range of mental health services to a current population of 665,000+. The post may change when/if the Clinical Director post moves to another clinician. The consultant will be a key team member on the same team as the Clinical Director, providing assessment of new referrals, crisis assessment, ongoing outpatient care, medication management, physical health and risk assessment. The consultant will provide leadership and oversight of clinical activities on the community mental health team that they are part of.

- Must be on the Specialist Register for Child & Adolescent Psychiatry maintained by the Medical Council in Ireland.
