

Consultant Psychiatrist

Bloomfield Health Services provide a spectrum of neuropsychiatric services to adults with a range of serious and enduring mental health issues such as schizophrenia and mood disorders. We also provide care for adults with neuropsychiatric disorders such as Alzheimer's disease, Parkinson's and Huntington's Diseases as well as individuals with Early Onset dementias. As a teaching hospital affiliated with Trinity College, Dublin, and engaging in transnational research programmes through, amongst others, the European JPND (Joint Programme Neurodegenerative Disease Research), Bloomfield is committed to being a leader in providing best practice in the treatment and care of a range of severe and enduring mental health conditions. Bloomfield also works closely with Huntington's disease Association of Ireland and the Neurological Alliance of Ireland.

In Bloomfield there is a focus on creating a therapeutic milieu utilising recovery oriented clinical practices and therapeutic interventions which are evidence based to enable and support patients to achieve their highest level of functioning and quality of life. This care is delivered with a Multidisciplinary Team including colleagues in Psychiatry, Psychology, Nursing, Pharmacy, Social Work, Occupational Therapy, Speech and Language, Dietetics, Physiotherapy and General Practice.

Bloomfield Health Services are inviting applications for the position of a **Consultant in General Adult Psychiatry with a Special Interest in Neuropsychiatry or Psychiatry of Later Life** for a permanent full-time role to commence in December 2021.

The Consultant Psychiatrist role will be to lead and develop a multi-disciplinary team to support the care of those with Neuropsychiatric and severe and enduring Psychiatric disorders in Bloomfield Hospital.

The successful post holder will work closely with the existing general adult and psychiatry of Later Life services in Bloomfield Health Services to provide in-patient mental health services for adults with severe and enduring mental illness and complex needs. Referrals are accepted to Bloomfield Hospital from across Ireland.

Key responsibilities will include:

- Overall responsibility for the provision of the services of a Psychiatrist to patients and residents and for the purpose of regulatory compliance.
- Support the continued development of Clinical Governance and to assist in the implementation of the strategic and operational plans of Bloomfield Health Services.
- Lead and develop a multidisciplinary clinical team in the inpatient specialist neuropsychiatric service.
- Provision by Bloomfield Health Services of Clinical Services within a legally compliant framework.
- Efficient, effective and economic provision of clinical services within a defined budgetary framework.
- Provision of teaching, research and academic support at a senior level as developed with colleagues in associated educational facilities, e.g. Trinity College Dublin and University College Dublin.
- There is an overlap in the care of inpatients and cross cover for leave.



Reporting Relationship

The post holder will report to the Clinical Director and will work closely with the Clinical Director to ensure provision of a comprehensive and responsive service.

The post is based on a 37 hour working week and an on call commitment will be delivered to the service.

The successful candidates will meet the following requirements:

- Full registration in the Specialist Register (Psychiatrist) of Medical Practitioners maintained by the Medical Council in Ireland or entitlement to be so registered.
- Seven years post-graduation experience.
- Registered as a general adult psychiatrist with a sub specialised interest in either Psychiatry of Later Life or Neuropsychiatry desirable.
- Have a management level or position of additional responsibility to their clinical area.
- Demonstrate an ability to lead change and to develop clinical services.
- Energetic individual with solid clinical experience in working with a team of diverse clinicians and strong knowledge of the concepts and operation of Clinical Governance.
- Strong ability to teach, manage, participate and play a key role in the practice and education of medical students, medical staff, nursing and other allied health professions and promote and engage in the teaching/training/support of others as appropriate.
- Have a good knowledge and experience of health, safety and other statutory regulations affecting a healthcare organisation.
- Ability to deliver core contracted hours and to undertake on call as a member of a rota.

Our Services

Bloomfield Health Services is an independent not for profit healthcare provider located at the foot of the Dublin Mountains at Stocking Lane in Rathfarnham Dublin 16. Bloomfield Mental Health Services provides specialist Neuropsychiatric assessment and continuing care services for individuals with complex mental health needs on a national basis and also specialises in the provision of mental health services to adults and older persons with serious and enduring mental health needs. We also provide specialist palliative care to individuals with mental health needs. Registered as an approved centre with the Mental Health Commission, Bloomfield Mental Health Services continues to develop its leadership role in innovative and effective treatment programmes for its patients. Referrals are accepted nationally. While providing excellence in clinical treatment and care to patients and their families, we are committed to training healthcare professionals and to conducting clinical research designed to enhance treatment programmes for the continued improvement of outcomes for patients and residents and the overall enhancement of their quality of life. We have formal academic links with Trinity College Dublin.

New Lodge Nursing Home
