Prof Kelly Allott is a Principal Research Fellow at Orygen and the Centre for Youth Mental Health, The University of Melbourne. She is also a Clinical Neuropsychologist in private practice. Kelly's research focuses on understanding cognition in early stage mental illness in youth and testing and developing treatments for supporting optimal cognitive health and functional recovery. She has published 160 papers and 6 book chapters and her work has been translated into various clinical resources and guidelines.
